Please be advised that as of this date I offer the following data regarding the Injured Warrior Fund of Florida.

1. Donations- At this time we have had several recent donations that are now included in my report. (Knights of Columbus in Inverness donated a check for \$3550.00 and the SgtMaj Thomas Griggs Detachment donated \$15,775, Estate of Ellen Shutkulis \$452.59, Fidelities Charities \$200.00, Pine Ridge Civic Assoc. @\$215.00, Indian River Det \$50.00 and the Legacy of Leesburg \$25.00 TOTAL \$20,267.59)

(2) We have assisted one individual (Charles R D. USMC), for the sum of \$2657.81. He is the 70th recipient. We are in the process of helping another unfortunate Marine with his request.

(3) Checking balance as of June 2019 is \$\$84,005.40 (See Paymaster's Report)

(4) The total amount of awards to individuals at this time is \$101,095.45. The number of recipients is now at 70.

(5) There was one (1) denial letter sent out to an individual who could not verify his statement as to his duty station or time of injuries. He claimed and could not again verify his cause of injuries, claiming his duty status was Top Secret in nature. In fact he was discharged as a conscious objector with no combat service. In addition we had one other request for monies but that individual never returned the application.

(8) I did appear before the District Vice and Commandants meeting at the Spring Conference to encourage more donations and applicants. I do again request that I be permitted to appear before both the District Vice and the Detachment Commandants to address them, with regard to the IWFF.
